FEBRUARY 17TH - CONGREGATION VITALITY SURVEY

Just like our physical bodies, the Church, as the body of Christ, needs to have regular check-ups to stay healthy, so we can be about our Father's business. Jesus, our Great Physician, knows what we need to do to be a vital and growing community of faith. And, so, it is important that we stay in constant communication with him as to how we are doing as a people of God. We are to be a house of prayer, continually asking for the Spirit's direction and guidance as to the plans God has for us, and the way he would have us fulfill those plans. This is called *discernment*.

We are always to be asking, "What is the Mission God has for us, in this community, at this time, in the life of our congregation?" "Are we going in the direction God is leading us?" "Are we all headed in the same direction, with the same purpose in mind?" "What steps do we need to take to exercise and strengthen our faith, so we can keep participating with God in his work?"

With this in mind, your Congregation Council has identified a great way to take our congregation's 'temperature', so to speak – to discover how well all of our many varied parts are working together. It is called a *Congregation Vitality Survey*. It is a short and easy to fill out *confidential* questionnaire designed to identify the health of Mt. Zion – St. Luke as a people of God. The information compiled from this data will help us discern where our energy and passion lies, so we can build on those strengths, and identify those areas of our ministry together that we need to build up.

We will be taking this survey on February 17th, when we gather for our Family Day Dinner. We will pray about it, then each of us will fill out the survey. Then, we will enjoy that great food that MZSL is famous for! You don't have to put your name on it, but you will need to mark your name off a list showing that you took the survey. We will bring you one later if you are unable to fill it out on the 17th.
